SCHOOL FEES - These fees are calculated based on the recommendations of Brisbane Catholic Education and are charged per term. There is no increase in Tuition Fees for 2019.

Trinity families who have children attending St Patrick's Parish Primary schools, St Joseph's and Mother Teresa can request a 20% concession on Tuition Fees (not levies) at the College.

A discount of 5% is offered when annual fees are paid in full prior to the commencement of the academic year.

CAPITAL LEVY - This is a compulsory levy charged per family. It is used to meet current and future commitments for building projects. This levy is not tax deductible.

PARENTS & FRIENDS LEVY - This levy is collected per family on behalf of the Trinity College P&F Association. The funds are used to complete projects at the discretion of the Committee.

RESOURCES & LEVIES - Resources and levies are the combination of compulsory classroom activities, the College's technology implementation levy, the 1:1 Laptop Program levy and Trinitext resources for each student attending the College.

THE FOLLOWING FEES ARE NOT INCLUDED – Externally provided Courses, Year 12 senior jersey, instrumental music lessons and some extra-curricular sporting events.

PAYMENT TERMS – Fees are payable 14 days from date of issue. Available Payment Options: **Cash, Cheque, BPoint, BPay** (min \$50), **Direct Debit, EFTPOS** or **Credit Card**.
