Goal – Middle Years: Improvement in the College's Years 7 & 9 NAPLAN Results [SYSTEM PRIORITY]

Strategies

- Implement Test Readiness Strategies
- Improve literacy and numeracy teaching practices in every Middle School classroom
- Literacy: Focus on writing composition/WATs/editing in Core English/History/R.E. classes

Success measures – Clear improvement in all aspects of the NAPLAN tests in both Years 7 & 9

Wellbeing

Goal – Student Resilience: Develop strategies in the Senior School to assist in aiding student resilience

Strategies

- Student Resilience Survey [4th. Year Longitudinal study]
- Analysis of results to develop core strategies in the Senior School to assist in building student resilience

Success measures – Aim for a 10% decrease in RTC referrals

Diversity and Inclusion

Goal – Increase student attendance [90% at 90%] to 70%

Strategies

- Present student attendance remains at a low of 60%
- Attendance Policy updated in 2020. Implementation has begun according to this policy

Success measures – Improvement in student attendance figures to 70% across all Year level cohorts
