Uniform Expectations and Guidelines

Students will wear full school uniform while in attendance at school, while travelling to and from school, and on special occasions. All items of the uniform should be clearly marked with the owner's name. Neatness, tidiness and cleanliness of uniform are essential, and no variations will be tolerated. T-shirts may be worn under the uniform in colder months as long as it cannot be seen through the shirt. Uniforms can only be purchased from the College Uniform Shop or online via the Parent Portal.

Glam and non-natural make up, nail polish, fake nails, fake eyelashes and eyelash extensions are not part of the school uniform. A watch, signet/plain ring and plain sleepers or studs in the ear are permitted. Studs may not exceed 5mm in diameter and sleepers may not extend more than 5mm from the edge of the ear and the outer edge of the sleeper. One nose ring which is plain, gold, silver or clear (no stones) stud, no greater than 1mm in diameter is permitted. In addition, it is permissible to wear a small, plain, discreet, silver or gold cross, religious or cultural icon on a fine chain around the neck. Any other item of jewelry is not to be seen.

Observable facial or body piercing is banned. Students are not permitted to cover any pierced objects with band aids nor are plugs, spacers or retainers acceptable.

Tattoos are not to be visible at any time.

Hairstyles are to be conservative, corporate and conform to the shape of the head. Excessiveness in style, colour, gel, or cut, which the College deems as extreme, will not be permitted at school or school events. This includes but is not limited to:

- All over crew cuts blade 1 and below
- Dreadlocks
- Decorative Tracks and lines
- Visible Rat tail (or similar)
- Mullets
- Mohawk/Fauxhawk

Cornrows or braids are permitted when they run uniformly from the front to the back of the head only. Students with shoulder length hair (touching the collar of the uniform) or longer are to have their hair tied back. Hair ties, clips and pins should be in one of the school colours or similar to the student's natural hair colour.

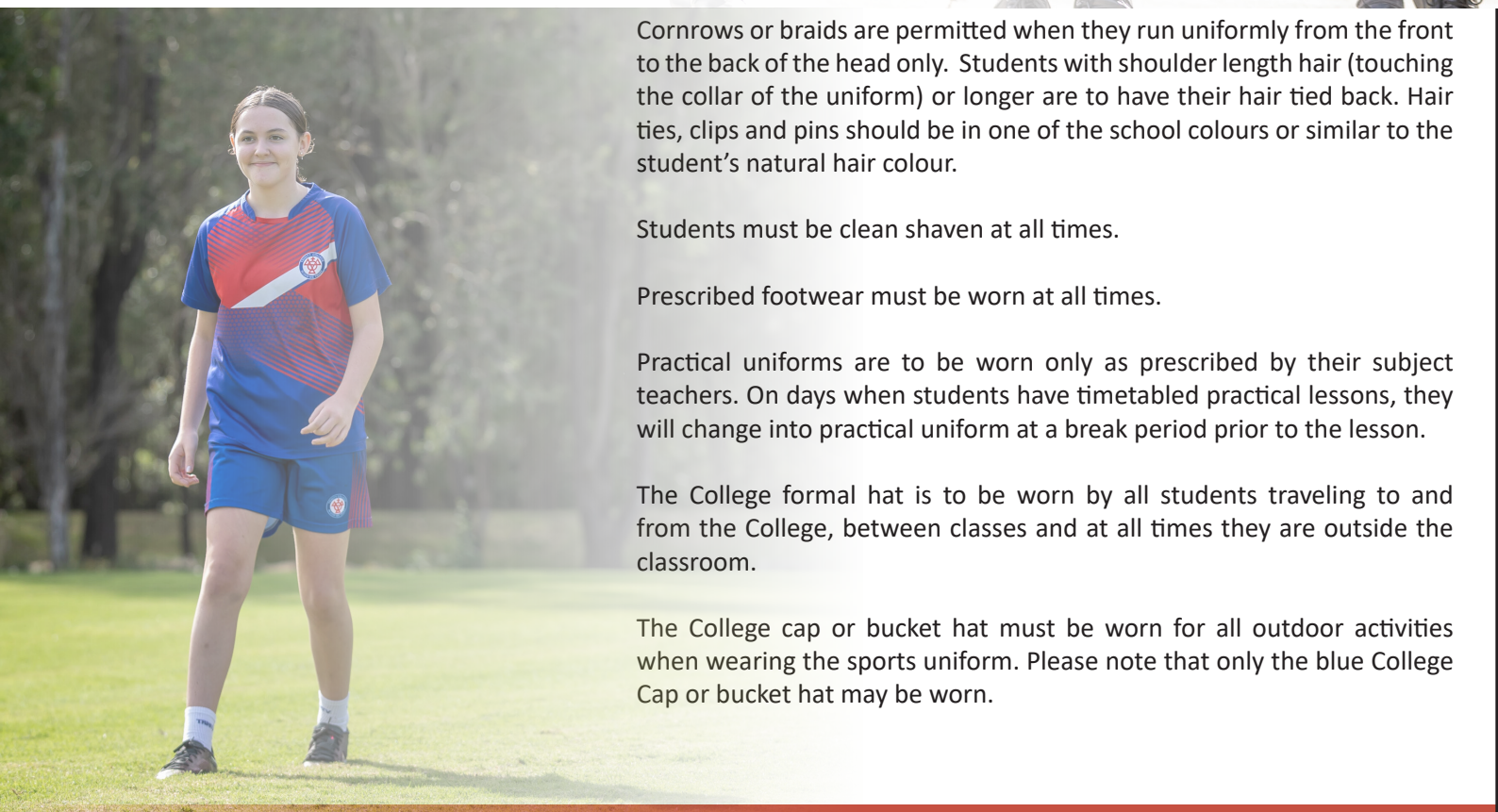
Students must be clean shaven at all times.

Prescribed footwear must be worn at all times.

Practical uniforms are to be worn only as prescribed by their subject teachers. On days when students have timetabled practical lessons, they will change into practical uniform at a break period prior to the lesson.

The College formal hat is to be worn by all students traveling to and from the College, between classes and at all times they are outside the classroom.

The College cap or bucket hat must be worn for all outdoor activities when wearing the sports uniform. Please note that only the blue College Cap or bucket hat may be worn.



Formal Uniform requirements

- Hat: College formal hat is to be worn by all students
- Blouses: Junior blouse with tie (years 7 – 9)
Senior blouse with tie year (10-12)
- Shirts: Junior blue shirt (with college tie for Terms 2 & 3)
Senior college shirt with long college tie
- Jackets: College soft shell jacket is to be worn with formal uniform
College Blazer to be worn in Years 11 and 12 during Terms 2 and 3 and formal occasions.
Senior Jersey (Year 12 only) may be worn under the Blazer each day
- Skirt: College skirt – length below the knee
- Pants: College grey shorts or long college grey trousers or pants
- Socks: White sockettes with college logo with blue skirt
Plain dark dress socks to be worn under long trousers or pants
College Grey socks with red line visible are to be worn with shorts
Stockings/Pantyhose may be worn but must be:
- opaque black/ebony and worn without sockettes or
 - natural sheer and worn with the college sockettes
- Shoes: Black leather lace-up shoes with regulation heel e.g. Clarkes or similar
- Belt: Black dress style belt
- Bag: College school bag only



Sport Uniform requirements

- Shirt: College sports shirt
- Shorts: College sports shorts
- Shoes: Supportive sports shoes
- Cap/Bucket Hat: Royal blue fabric with Logo
- Socks: White college sockette or sports sock with logo

*SASD, Dance and La Valla Trade Training Uniforms are to be worn as prescribed for the subject area.

*Uniforms purchased as part of a College team, club or association are not to be worn as part of the formal or sport uniform.
